Trip Code of Conduct

Please read the following Trip Code of Conduct. Student and at least one parent/guardian must sign this agreement. Student and parent/guardian signature indicate agreement to abide by rules listed below.

- This is a Cobb County field trip. All school rules apply. Students are expected to exemplify responsible behavior at all times. Trip participants represent their families, our community, and Walton High School.
- Possession of and/or drinking alcoholic beverages, taking illegal non-prescription drugs, and use of tobacco or nicotine products will not be tolerated. Any violation will cause immediate dismissal and return to Marietta at the student and parents' expense.
- All students must travel on their assigned bus only; no switching. There will be no switching of hotel rooms.
- No "horseplay" during the trip.
- Students are not permitted on hotel balconies.
- All students must participate in all activities, including meals. Be on time.
- A "buddy system" must be adhered to at all times during the trip. If any student participant is seen without a fellow student buddy or group, the chaperone who spots the student will become that student's buddy until another student or group is located.
- All personal entertainment equipment must have headphones.
- Bring electronics, jewelry and/or other valuables at your own risk.
- Students are advised to keep their spending money with them. Do not leave it in your hotel room.
- Hotel room doors are to be locked & curtains must be closed at all times.
- No boys will be permitted in girls' rooms. No girls will be permitted in boys' rooms.
- Charges to the hotel room are not permitted.
- Calls between rooms only as necessary until lights out. No local or long distance calls from hotel phones. Use cell phones.
- Lights out rule will be strictly enforced. After lights out, students are not to leave their rooms for any reason. If an emergency should arise, contact your assigned chaperone.
- Parents and students will be held responsible for paying for any property damage.
- Chaperones, bus drivers, hotel, and travel agency staff are to be shown proper respect at all times.
- Respect must be shown to student bus captains and loading captains at all times.
- Keep the buses clean! Use the garbage bags on board.
- Extreme caution is advised with strangers. Do not leave our group. Never give out your room number or hotel location. Do not go anywhere with strangers.
- You are completely responsible for your belongings. Do not expect anyone else to unload and carry your baggage and/or equipment. Have all luggage and instruments clearly marked with your name, address, telephone number and section.
